ACTIVITY DESCRIPTION

Jugend:Info NÖ is the Lower Austrian youth information organization, dedicated to empowering young people through accessible and relevant information. Our motto, "You don't have to know everything," reflects our goal to support youth and those who work with them by offering free, up-to-date, and easy-to-understand guidance on topics like education, employment, and opportunities abroad.

This project focuses on multimedia work, inviting European Solidarity Corps (ESC) volunteers to engage in creative documentation and content creation, where the German language skills are helpful. Volunteers will be actively involved in producing videos, podcasts, and social media content that highlight Jugend:Info NÖ's key activities, project, and events. This includes capturing and promoting our annual highlight: the Youth Speech Competition, a major national event held every spring that gathers young talents from all over Lower Austria to share their voices on important social topics.

ESC participants will have the opportunity to creatively document events, interview participants, and develop innovative multimedia projects that bring youth perspectives to life. This project is perfect for those passionate about multimedia, storytelling, youth work and eager to learn German language.

The second part of this project will involve engaging with a Youth Center in Loosdorf, where volunteers will contribute to creating an inclusive and dynamic environment for young people. Working in a Youth Center involves creating a welcoming space for young people to connect, learn, and grow. Activities include organizing workshops, events, and recreational programs that encourage creativity, teamwork, and skill-building. Staff and volunteers support youth in developing their interests, addressing challenges, and fostering a sense of community through meaningful engagement and collaboration.





THE REGION OF ST. PÖLTEN

Located in the heart of Lower Austria, the St. Pölten region is known for its blend of historical charm and modern flair. As the state capital, it features beautiful baroque architecture, vibrant cultural events, and a lively student scene. Surrounded by picturesque landscapes, it's perfect for nature lovers and outdoor activities. With its rich heritage and strong community spirit, St. Pölten offers a welcoming atmosphere. St. Pölten is also a dynamic student city, thanks to its universities and vocational schools, making it a lively place full of young people, creativity, and innovation. Its excellent public transport connections to Vienna and other major cities in Austria make it a perfect place for both living and exploring the region. With a combination of rich heritage, active youth culture, and strong community spirit, the St. Pölten region is a welcoming and inspiring environment for locals and visitors alike.

Accommodation close to the place of work is provided. The coordinating organisation will provide pocket money, money to buy basic necessities and a travel allowance. Volunteers receive €180 pocket money, €300 for meals, and €45 for public transport monthly, ensuring essential expenses are covered while they focus on their activities.

PARTICIPANTS PROFILE

We are looking for enthusiastic and creative young people (aged 18-30) who are passionate about multimedia, storytelling, and youth work. Ideal candidates should have an interest in creating videos, podcasts, or social media content and be eager to develop their skills in a dynamic, youth-focused environment. Previous experience in multimedia or event documentation is a plus but not required.

Participants should be open-minded, proactive, and comfortable working both independently and as part of a team.

A good command of English, and basic knowledge of German is recommended. Most importantly, candidates should be motivated to engage in youth projects and contribute their unique perspective to empowering young people.

You will attend an on arrival training as well as a mid term meeting hosted by the Austrian National Agency. In addition to the training opportunities that are part of the ESC programme, volunteers can participate in internal training and development at the site.



We also organise an ESC Volunteer Day twice a year to get to know each other. As part of this, we visit a chosen part of Lower Austria to learn and experience the local language, history and culture.
